As chair of the Gulf Coast Ecosystem Restoration Council, I am pleased to approve the Alabama Planning State Expenditure Plan submitted pursuant to the Spill Impact Component of the *Resources and Ecosystems Sustainability, Tourist Opportunities, and Revived Economies of the Gulf Coast States Act of 2012*, 33 U.S.C. §1321(t).

This approval is based on the written finding from the council's executive director that the PSEP is complete and meets all requirements contained in the RESTORE Act, the U.S. Department of the Treasury's implementing regulations (31 C.F.R. Part 34) and the council's SEP guidelines.
